Defibuary

When someone goes into cardiac arrest, their heart goes into a life threatening rhythm. Without early intervention of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (also known as CPR) and defibrillation, a patient's chance of surviving decreases by 10% every minute. To raise public awareness about defibrillators, throughout February we held our annual Twitter #Defibuary Campaign. We encouraged staff, volunteers and the public to tweet us selfies with new defibrillators locations. We would like to say a massive thank you to everyone who got involved submitting 187 selfies. As a result 39 Defibs in unregistered locations have now been added onto our database for our 999 colleagues and available for the public on the NHS Direct Wales website. Defibuary

Pan fydd rhywun yn mynd i ataliad y galon, mae eu calon yn mynd i rythm sy'n bygwth bywyd. Heb ymyrraeth gynnar o Dadebru Cardiopulmonar (a elwir hefyd yn CPR) a difibriliad, mae siawns claf o oroesi yn gostwng o 10% bob munud. Er mwyn codi ymwybyddiaeth y cyhoedd am ddifibrilwyr, ym mis Chwefror cynhaliwyd ein hymgyrch Twitter blynyddol sef #Defibuary. Fe wnaethom annog staff, gwirfoddolwyr a'r cyhoedd i drydar 'selfies' i ni gyda lleoliadau difibrilwyr newydd. Hoffem ddweud diolch anferth i bawb a gymerodd ran i gyflwyno 187 o luniau. O ganlyniad, mae 39 defibrilwyr mewn lleoliadau anghofrestredig bellach wedi'u hychwanegu at ein cronfa ddata ar gyfer ein cydweithwyr 999 ac ar gael i'r cyhoedd ar wefan Galw Iechyd Cymru.
